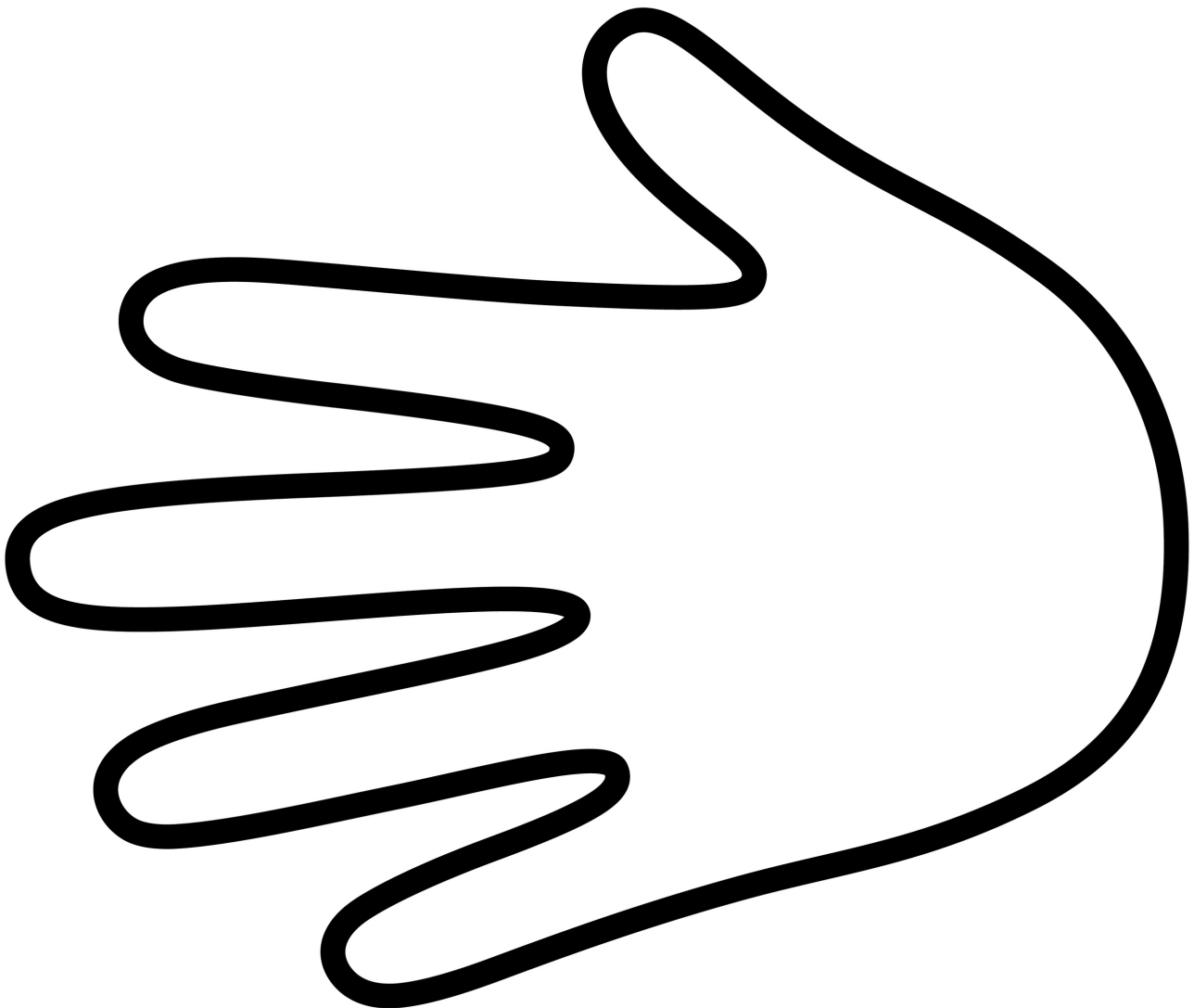




Trees of Hope
